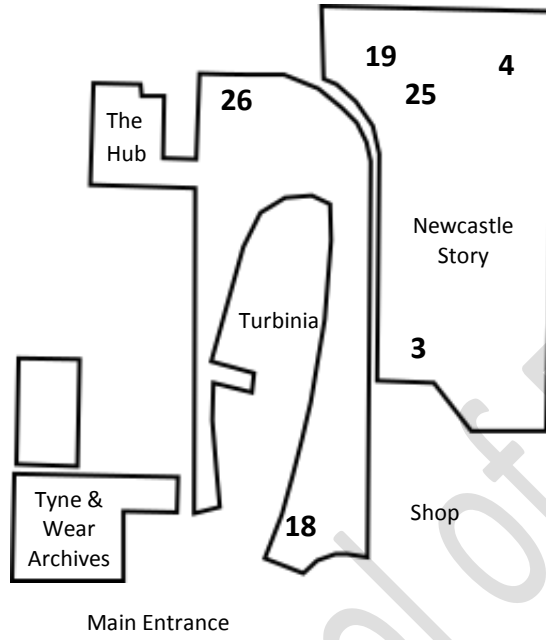


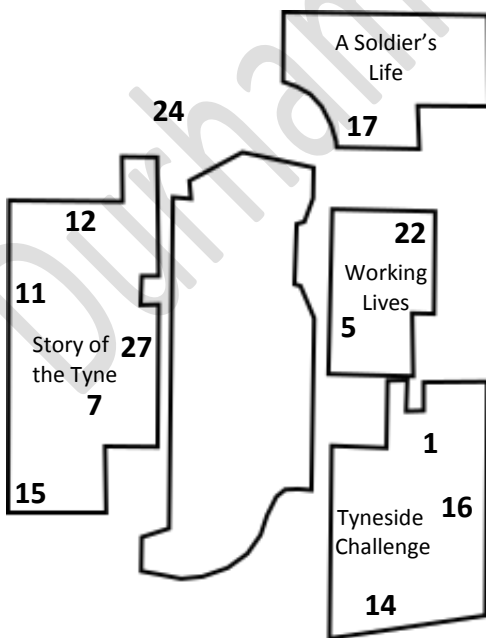

Museum Map

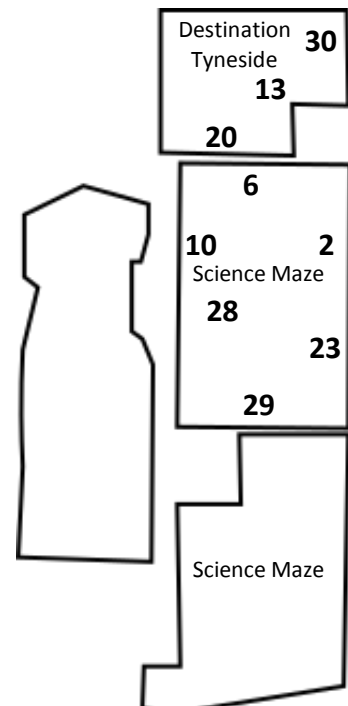
Ground Floor
